1. Rules

- 1.1. All races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS)* as published by World Sailing. The prescriptions of this Notice of Race (NOR) and the Sailing Instructions (SIs) will apply.
- 1.2. In the event of any conflict between these rules, those of the SIs will prevail.
- 1.3. The exoneration penalty (and the advisory and RYA arbitration) of the RYA disputes procedures will be available.
- 1.4. The following Rules will be subject to change: RRS 27.1; RRS 40; RRS 44.1; RRS 60.1(a); RRS 64.2; RRS A5.1; RRS A5.2; Race Signal ICF 'L'; Appendix S 11.1

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. The Event is open to all sailors under the age of 19. Entries will be accepted up to 1015 on 14th September 2024.
- 2.2. Competitors may enter online: http://www.boughbeechsc.org.uk/open-racing
- 2.3. Substitution of helm or crew after registration will only be considered following written application to the Race Committee.

3. Fees

- 3.1. Entry fees will be £10 per visiting doublehanded boat and £7.50 per visiting singlehanded boat.
- 3.2. There is no fee for BBSC members entering the Emma Nettleship Regatta.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. A briefing will take place in the Clubhouse at 1015 on 14th September 2024.
- 4.2. Schedule of races:

Date	Number of races	Earliest time of first Warning Signal
14th September 2024	6 races	1055hrs

- 4.3. No warning signal will be given before 1055. No warning signal will be given after 1600.
- 4.4. The intention is to run two races back-to-back in the morning and two races back-to-back in the afternoon. Any amendments to this schedule will be posted on the official notice board.

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available on the Bough Beech SC website and at registration in the Clubhouse.

6. Courses

6.1. The course to be sailed will be displayed on the Club notice board, and on the course board in the main boathouse.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. The scoring system of RRS Appendix A4 will apply (see RRS 90.3).
- 7.2. A minimum of one race is required to be completed to constitute the series.
- 7.3. The number of races a boat may exclude from her score (or the number of races to count) will depend on the number of races completed, as follows:

Races completed	Races to count
6 races	5 races
5 races	4 races
4 races	3 races
3 races	3 races
2 races	2 races
1 race	1 race

8. Prizes

- 8.1. Prizes for the Youth Open will be awarded for first, second, and third position overall. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the BBSC Organising Committee.
- 8.2. Members of Bough Beech SC are eligible for the Emma Nettleship Regatta.
- 8.3. Prize will be awarded for first School boat.

9. Risk Statement

9.1. RRS 3 states "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or continue to races is hers alone". By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for any material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. Insurance

10.1. It is a condition of entry that each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance adequate to cover all third-party claims.

11. Rights and Copyright

11.1. By participating in this event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show at their discretion any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped, or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her during this event and of all his/her material related to the regatta, without compensation.

12. Data Protection

12.1. In order to manage the event, information provided by competitors will be held on a database. APPENDIX A: SES Water Rules

A.1. Invasive Species

All participating boats will be expected to have met the Club's protective procedure against invasive species before entering SES Water grounds.

A.2. Dogs

Under the terms of SES Water's byelaws, dogs are not permitted on the premises of the Club, its grounds or car parks. Competitors **will** be asked to leave the premises if this byelaw is breached.

APPENDIX B: Additional Information

B.1. Social

The galley will be open all day for a wide variety of hot and cold food. This is cooked to order and **must** be ordered before going afloat. All visitors, including shore side visitors are advised to order before 1100.
